Use this sheet to help your child to come up with ideas to feel better when they have difficult feelings.

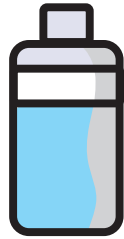

Take some deep breaths



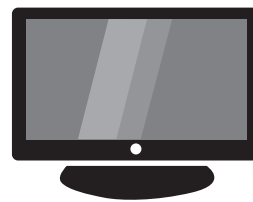
